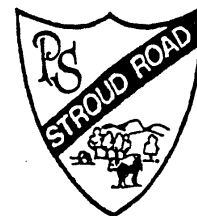

From the Principal's Desk:

Welcome to week 3 of this term already! It is a busy week with swimming being held and the combined swimming carnival completing the week on Friday.

Active After School Program:

Yesterday we commence our term one program with archery for the students in Years 2-6. The students in kindergarten and year 1 will still be participating in active after school activities, however they will be completing other fun activities on Monday afternoons.

Today we have commenced our second activity of golf. We are running this program with the assistance of Mark from the Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation. We are looking forward to another great term of fun activities. Please remember to pick students up at 3:30 on Mondays and Tuesdays.

Swimming:

This week we are making up the four missed sessions of intensive swimming from 2011. Please ensure that the students have all the necessary materials including swimmers and a plastic bag to put their wet swimmers in when finished. Marion and Carolyn will again be our instructors for these lessons.

Swimming Carnival:

On Friday the students who are eight years and older will be representing our school at the combined swimming carnival at the Stroud Pool. This is held with both Stroud and Booral PS and is always a wonderful day. Students need to be dropped off at Stroud pool at 9.15am (the carnival is commencing at 9.30am) and picked up between 2:30 and 2:45pm, depending upon the finishing time. Please ensure that students have sunscreen, a hat, and plenty of fluids. Students in Kinder and Year 1 will come to school and spend the day with Mrs Madden and Mrs Melmeth.

Class Information Meetings:

Next week the staff will be holding class information meetings to share what we will be teaching this term and to share other information regarding our routines. These meetings are not parent teacher interviews and we will not have time to speak about individual students during this meeting. Priority School Funding Program Surveys:

Shortly we will be sending home the Priority Schools Funding Program surveys to be completed. We need to have a 100% return rate on these surveys and if we are successful in getting on this program it will provide the school with many, many benefits. Further information on the surveys will be sent home in the lead up to the survey period and we will also hold a parent session to explain the survey and what it all means.

Visitor Policy:

One of the topics that was discussed on our staff development day was the implementation of our visitors policy.

The key components for parents, caregivers and visitors are:

- * To sign in when entering the school and to put on a visitors badge. The table will be over near the classroom buildings. By signing in, it enables the staff to know who is in the school in case of an emergency situation and for security.
- * When leaving the school grounds, please sign out and return the visitors badge.
- * Parents are always welcome to visit the school but departmental policy recommends that the school staff room not be entered without staff being present due to the nature of confidential documents being found in this area.
- * The administration office will be locked when unattended as the teachers can see who is coming and going whilst they are teaching the students.
- * If parents and caregivers wish to take their students early from school, it is requested that they complete the book to state student's name, time taken and reason. These details will be entered into the teacher's class rolls.
- * If a student arrives at school after 9:10am, it is requested that the parent/caregiver fill in the late arrivals book. This is due to the classroom teachers marking their roll at 9:00am and the student will be marked as absent. The details completed in the late arrivals book will need to be entered into the teachers class rolls.
