Legacy

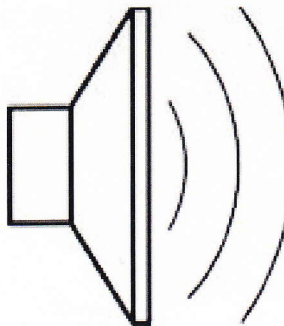

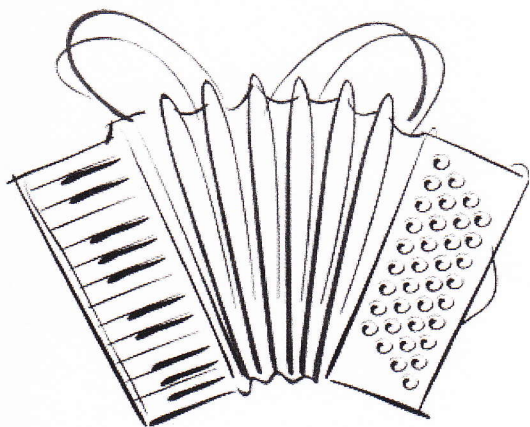
