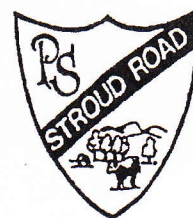

From the Principal's Desk:

Solar installation:

Yesterday was a very exciting day for our school as we had our solar installed on the roof of the hall building. We were very lucky to be successful in gaining a grant which allowed for the installation of this new system.

We have 28 solar panels on the building and they will be generating a large amount of power to run our school and to reduce our electricity costs.

Bucketts of Talent Concert:
