The costs are as follows:

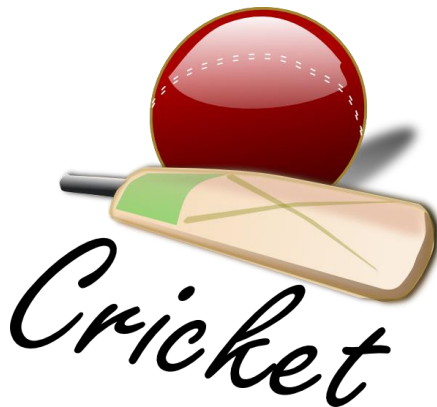
