Well done to Kaiden, Ben, Lachlan, Lucy and Elijah who were our super spellers on Friday, getting 100% in their spelling test.



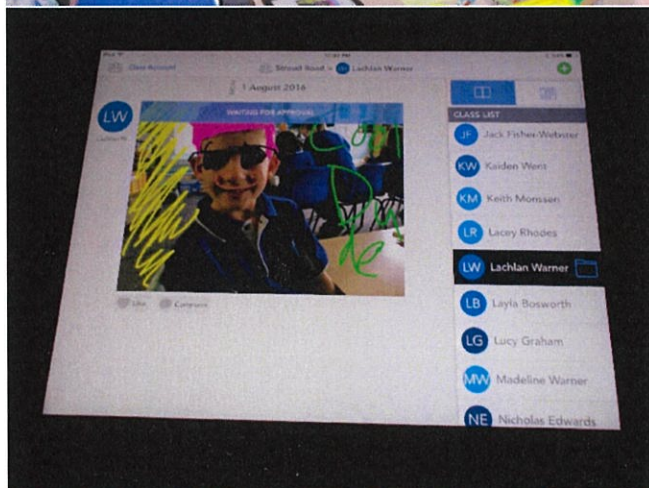
IPADS
