
STANDOUT STUDENT AWARD

Chat with the Chappie

Last week the kids and I talked about what 'good character' is. It is not something we're just born with. Babies don't arrive being responsible and self-disciplined! It takes time to develop these traits. The other traits we discussed are below:

- Integrity, honesty & loyalty
- Respectfulness, humility & compassion
- Fairness, forgiveness & authenticity
- Courage, generosity & perseverance
- Politeness, kindness & lovingness
- Optimism, reliability & conscientiousness

When you look at all those traits, which ones would you highlight as being the most important ones? Which ones do you see very little of today? The world we live in is changing and it sometimes seems that good character traits are not valued like they used to be.

Which of the above traits do you see in your kids? Which ones would you like to see more of? (Sometimes that's the easier question to answer!)

As parents, when we see certain areas lacking in our kids, it is our responsibility to help them grow and learn, rarely do these traits just come naturally. I want to encourage you to invest in your kids today, get creative and find ways to help develop these traits. What you invest in today will affect the kind of adult your child is in the future.
