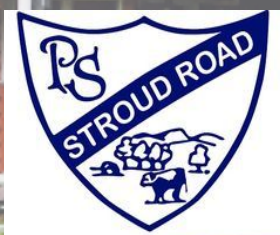

Hayley has greatly improved her use of persuasive language when constructing arguments in her writing. She is able to convince an audience to believe her point of view using excellent structure and ideas.

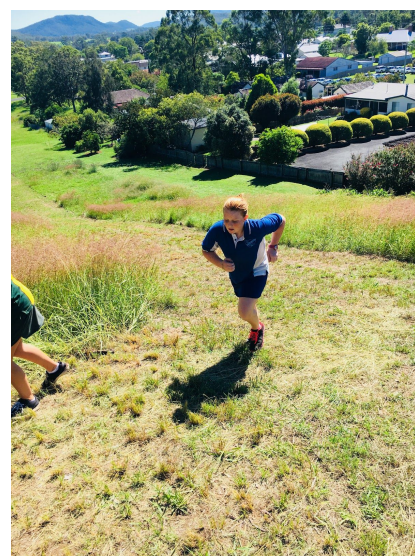
